The 2020 changes to ICD-10-CM will become effective on October 1, 2019. Listed below are the new codes and revisions we believe are of most interest to pediatricians. Please see your 2020 ICD-10-CM Code Book for a complete list of changes and to verify all new and revised codes.

**S02.12-** Fracture of orbital roof, closed fracture

**S02.83-** Fracture of medial orbital wall, closed fracture

**S02.84-** Fracture of lateral orbital wall, closed fracture

The appropriate sixth character to be added to these codes

**1**—right side

**2**—left side

**9**—unspecified side

The appropriate seventh character to be added to these codes

**A**—initial encounter for closed fracture

**B**—initial encounter for open fracture

**D**—subsequent encounter for fracture with routine healing

**G**—subsequent encounter for fracture with delayed healing

**K**—subsequent encounter for fracture with nonunion

**S**—sequela

**T50.911-** Poisoning by multiple unspecified drugs, medicaments and biological substances

The appropriate sixth character to be added

**1**—accidental (unintentional)

**2**—intentional self-harm

**3**—assault

**4**—undetermined

**5**—adverse effect

**6**—underdosing

A—initial encounter  
D—subsequent encounter

**T67.01X-** Heatstroke and sunstroke

**Z22.7** Latent tuberculosis

**Z71.84** Encounter for health counseling related to travel  
**Z86.15** Personal history of latent tuberculosis infection
